Terms and Conditions

1. Fees (*):

Lesson fees are subject to annual review on the 1st January. Where Lesson fees are increased as a result of such a review, the Teacher shall endeavour to give the Student at least one month's notice of such increase.

2. Missed lessons

Any individual lesson missed by the student will be rescheduled if the student/parent let the Teacher knows at least 24 hours in advance. In the case of sickness or emergency, if the student notify the Teacher as soon as possible, preferably before 9 am on the lesson day, then only half of the lesson fees will be charged.

If the Student fails to notice in time, the lesson will be charged fully.

3. Attendance

Students are expected to arrive on time. If the student is running late for any reason, please call or text the teacher as soon as possible. The lesson time will not be extended because the student is late, and it will still be charged the full amount for that lesson.

If the teacher is running late for any reason, he/she will notify the student as soon as possible and make up the full lesson time to the student.

4. Payment:

For the booking of trial lessons, the payment has to be made 48 hours prior to the lesson.

Then lesson fees will be collected on or before every first lesson of a lessons package, either by cash or by bank transferral, otherwise tuition can be withheld until received.

5. General:

- a. Student and Teacher will let each other know about any eventual last-minute circumstance.
- b. Neither party shall be liable to the other party for any breach by the other of any of the terms and conditions herein occasioned by any act of God, war, revolution, riot, civil disturbance, strike, lock-out, flood, fire or other cause not reasonably within the control of such party.
- c. Examination entries, festivals, competitions or otherwise will only be entered if the Student and Teacher are in agreement. Any entry fees will be paid for by the Student.
- d. If the Student is under eighteen, the Student's parent or guardian gives permission for the Teacher to teach the Student.

NOTES FOR GUIDANCE:

- It is important to note that whilst a Teacher will use his or her best endeavours to ensure the Student makes satisfactory progress, this cannot be guaranteed. In particular, careful regular practice as advised by the Teacher is a prerequisite of success on any musical instrument or in any musical endeavour.
